The National Trail Parks and Recreation District (NTPRD), in cooperation with a community citizens' committee, is currently conducting fundraising efforts to construct a community dog park. This project has an estimated fundraising goal for construction, programming, and future maintenance of \$35,000.

The proposed dog park will include fencing, water, irrigation, landscaping, and park amenities. It will be located in the southern end of Old Reid Park and will encompass approximately two to three acres and will offer areas for large and small dogs.

Members of the NTPRD Dog Park Committee are currently contacting community businesses and individuals to seek financial support for this exciting, new community project with a planned opening date of spring 2005.
