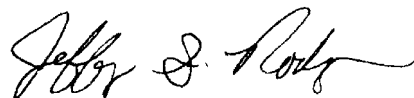

The Water Park Assistant Manager is responsible, under the direction of the Park Manager to supervise the day-to-day operations of the Splash Zone Water Park. Responsible for assisting in maintaining the pool, water quality, operations, mechanics and maintenance of the park in accordance with all District, County, State, and OSHA requirements and standards, and maintaining records and documentation as required. Responsible for assisting in the hiring, staffing, discipline, evaluation, and training of all Park staff. Will assist in meeting the needs of guests and ensuring that guests have a quality experience. Will assist with daily accounting and processing of all revenues and monitoring the budget for the season; maintains accurate financial and operational records and reports as required. Will monitor supplies for the Park as needed for pool operation, concessions, and maintenance.

This position requires current certifications in Lifeguard, First Aid, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, Bloodborne pathogens, Pool Operator, Lifeguard Instructor and Water Safety Instructor. The Assistant Manager must have a broad background in aquatics in both administrative and supervisory capacities. Requires experience in the maintenance and water quality of an aquatic facility. This position requires a professional with skills in managing self, others and the ability to establish and maintain productive relationships with the public, park staff, and community stakeholders.
