Unique Characteristics/Observations

- A destination park
- Soccer focused park with few other primary uses
- Wide expanse of open space

Recommendations

- Incorporate other family oriented uses such as play areas, bike trails, shelters, and dog parks
- Construct warming shelter with fire place at north end of park
- Construct a storage/concession/and permanent restroom structure centrally located
- Provide multiple age playground areas
- Construct a looped 6' asphalt trail around the entire park
- Construct a 6' asphalt pedestrian connection to the Simon Kenton Trail
- Integrate more green spaces and trees into parking lots and main entry drive
- Plant trees throughout the site for shade and wind barrier
- Provide additional multi-use fields along the north park boundary for soccer and/or football
- Implement new graphic standards
 - Identification and regulatory/directional signage
- Formalize a management plan
- Access water for drinking and irrigation purposes
