Unique Characteristics/Observations

- Linear park extending from Sherman Ave. to Simon Kenton Trail
- Dual access points
- Ends of park appear to be used more than central portion
- No easy access to the Buck Creek
- Not well integrated into the neighborhood
- Trail is on opposite side of creek from park

Recommendations

- Improve parking lots
- Create an internal trail system to help tie the park together and better integrate it into the neighborhood
- Construct a picnic shelter at the north end as shown in plan
- Construct a tot lot at the north end as shown in plan
- Provide restroom at north end as shown in plan
- Improve the north entry from Northern Avenue and provide signage
- Remove backstop
- Implement new graphic standards
 - Identification and interpretive signage
- Formalize a management plan
- Create a natural environment throughout the northern section of the park. Stop dumping of construction and raw materials in this location and begin the removal of such existing piles
