Recommendations

- Make major improvements to annual Arts Festival:
 - Stage
 - Expand existing pavilion
 - Construct new Concession/Restroom Building
 - Spectator seating
 - VIP and Sponsor Areas
 - Lighting and sound
 - ADA access
 - Truck and bus access
- Provide needed infrastructure upgrades for electrical service, roadway lighting, sanitary, water, and sewer
- Improve connection to Wittenburg Avenue with a multi-use trail
- Add site fixtures and furnishings for Festival as well as year-round use including drinking fountains, benches, trash receptacles, bike racks, and picnic tables
- Implement new graphic standards with identification signage
- Improve boardwalk access behind stage at cliffs to meet current safety standards
- Improve separation between Cliff Park Drive and Buck Creek Scenic Trail by eliminating gravel pull off along south berm
- Coordinate with Wittenburg University on the vehicular access through the existing parking lot for festival use
- Add landscaping and entrance features at key locations
