NTPRD reserves the right to cancel or postpone any program/activity upon which the customer is entitled to a full refund of the program fee in the form of a check.





## GEOCACHING POLICY OF THE NATIONAL TRAIL PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT

- Written permission in the form of a permit from the National Trail Parks and Recreation District must be obtained before placement of any cache on Park property. There is no permit fee.
- Each cache will be issued a permit number. The cache or container must be labeled on the outside with the issued permit number. Each geocache must have a separate permit even if the same person is applying.
- · A permit is valid for one year. After the expiration date, the cache must be re-permitted or removed and archived
- Geocachers will have access to all NTPRD parks, but there will be an allowable limit.

Neighborhood Parks: 1 cache Community Parks: 3 caches

- Placement of a cache must be within 15 feet of the edge of a trail. No hikers are permitted off trail/bushwhacking in any of the NTPRD parks.
- NTPRD has the right to set a limit of caches in one park and will deny future requests on grounds of effective management. After one year of placement, it is NTPRD's right to ask for removal of a cache which would make an opening for other cachers to make placement.
- NTPRD must be notified when a cache is moved or eliminated.
- · No burying or climbing is permitted; caches must be at ground level. Cutting trees, shrubs or plants is also prohibited.
- Container contents must be legal and suitable for all ages.
- The cache owner is responsible for care and monitoring of the cache while on NTPRD property. Please monitor often enough to determine if clues or physical features are current. (Monthly is recommended).
- Caches placed in NTPRD parks must be available to the public via a public website. Caches for private access will not be accepted.
- All NTPRD park rules must be followed including the use of parks during daylight hours only.
- Any geocache found by NTPRD not in compliance with these rules or determined not to be in the best interest of the Park District will be removed and permit revoked.
