Estel Wenrick Wetlands Nature Preserve provides a casual opportunity for hikers and nature lovers to see a thriving wetland area. Located in Bethel Township, the 145 acre wetland is managed in partnership with B-W Greenway Community Land Trust.

Spangler Nature Preserve is one of the newest parks for the Clark County Park District. Thanks to the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund grant program managed by the Ohio Public Works Commission and a partnership with the B-W Greenway Community Land Trust, the Clark County Park District acquired the Leadingham Farm south of the Estel Wenrick Wetlands and other properties south of Spangler Road, encompassing 166 acres. The Preserve includes nearly two miles of walking trails through the prairie, access to the Mad River, and a newly planted wet woods.

The wetlands and nature preserve is home to great blue heron, Cooper's hawk, beaver, and many species of wildflowers and trees. The wet soils throughout this area create a unique habitat to support many different species not found in other nearby preserves.
